## Environmental Policy

The Tryall Club recognizes that our business has a vital role to play in protecting and enhancing the environment for its members and guests, and for the residents of Jamaica. With this objective in mind our Club is committed to taking action:

- To provide all employees with the training and resources required to meet our environmental objectives, and through this medium to sustain focused environmental programs.
- To openly communicate our policies and practices to our employees, members, guests and interested parties in fulfillment of our goal to increase environmental awareness.
- To monitor and record our environmental performance yearly, relative to our policies, objectives and targets, and to ensure continuous improvement in our practices.
- To be committed to the equal opportunity employment of persons who reside in nearby communities so that the benefits of the Club's operational programs are shared within a wider community.
- To purchase local goods and services which are of no adverse effects to the Club's general operations or have a negative environmental or social impact.
- To initiate an annual review of the Environmental and Social Sustainability Policy that determines whether targets for continuous improvement have been realized by the organization, and provide Green Globe 21 this data annually.
- To preserve national monuments on site in compliance with the standards of the National Heritage Trust, and to foster the interest of guests and members in such national treasures.
- To maintain our support of charities piloted by the Tryall Fund and embrace the development of health and educational programs for surrounding communities.
